1. CALL TO ORDER/WELCOME VISITORS

Mayor Belisle called the meeting to order & welcomed all. Mayor Belisle made motion to amend the agenda under #4-D for Baggarly Way Safety Concerns. Motion was 2nd by C. Owens and carried unanimously.

2. APPROVAL OF MARCH 21, 2011 PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES

C. Fisher made motion to approve the March 21, 2011 Public Hearing minutes as presented & was 2nd by C. Owens. Motion carried unanimously.

APPROVAL OF MARCH 21, 2011 CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

C. Graham made motion to approve the March 21, 2011 City Council minutes as presented & was 2nd by C. Owens. Motion carried unanimously.

3. ADMINISTRATIVE/FISCAL MATTERS

A. Approval of Architect for City Hall Improvements

Mayor Belisle made motion to approve Home Design Dynamics, Inc. as the architect for City Hall improvements at a cost of \$3,950. Motion was 2nd by C. Fisher & carried unanimously.

B. Arbor Day Resolution

Mayor Belisle made motion to approve Resolution No. 11-05 declaring Saturday, April 16, 2011 as Arbor Day in the City. Motion was 2nd by C. Graham & carried unanimously.

C. MUTCD Retro Reflectivity Requirement Plan

C. Owens made motion that the City begin to purchase the Retro Reflectivity Signage and bars at an estimated cost of 22,000 which is to be funded from the current Street Dept. line item 52.206 for Street Maintenance with excess coming from SPLOST. Motion was 2nd by Mayor Belisle & carried unanimously.

5. NEW BUSINESS

A. 2nd Read 11.233 Acres on GA Hwy 16 Annexation/Zoning Ordinance

C. Owens made motion to approve the 2nd Read on the Annexation/Zoning of 11.233 Acres on GA. Hwy 16. Motion was 2nd by C. Fisher & carried unanimously.

B. 1st Read Rezoning of 7.332 Acres on Coweta Street from R40 to IIR

Mayor Belisle made motion to approve the 1st Read on the Tranquil Village rezoning from R-40 to IIR to include developer responsible for bringing the street up to City standards and extending sewer to the nearest manhole. Motion was 2nd by C. Graham & carried unanimously.

C. Chief Edens-Gang Information Seminar

Chief Edens introduced Investigator Alicia Batts who announced a Gang Information Seminar has been scheduled for Monday, April 18th at the Freeman Sasser Building at 7 PM. With the seminar scheduled for the same night as the next Council meeting, C. Graham asked that it be re-scheduled for April 25th so that any that attend Council meetings can also attend the seminar. Inv. Batts will check for availability of the building and will notify the press if date and time are changed.

D. Safety Concerns on Baggarly Way

Chief Edens informed all that the condition of Baggarly from 42 Main down to Gin Street has become unsafe and would like the City to close it until asphalt repairs can be done. City Attorney Drew Whalen stated that proper signage would be sufficient instead of closure. Mayor Belisle will create a work order for the Public Works Department in the morning for ordering signage until the repairs can be completed.

- Tony Bell of the Optimist Club reported that Taste of Senoia was a very successful event and thanked all involved.
- Marshall Huckaby explained that his son Brian is serving his 2nd tour in Iraq and Brian is very appreciative of what Senoia has done to recognize all Veterans. Mr. Huckaby then presented the City an American Flag that was flown on an actual mission in Iraq with the Alpha Company Devils on January 4, 2011. Along with the Flag is a personally signed certificate from the Alpha Crew thanking the City for its support of all Veterans. Mayor Belisle thanked Mr. Huckaby and sent thanks to his son Brian and the crew for their service to our Country.
