FULL COUNCIL PRESENT

1. CALL TO ORDER/WELCOME VISITORS

Mayor Belisle called the meeting to order, welcomed all and C. Fisher led the Pledge of Allegiance. Mayor Belisle then declared this to be an open meeting duly convened under the Open Meetings law after receiving confirmation from the City Clerk that all legal requirements have been met.

2. APPROVAL OF OCTOBER 7, 2013 CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

C. Grover made motion to approve the October 7, 2013 Council minutes as presented & was 2nd by C. Owens. Motion carried unanimously.

APPROVAL OF OCTOBER 18, 2013 WORKSESSION MINUTES

C. Graham made motion to approve the October 18, 2013 Work Session minutes as presented & was 2nd by C. Owens. Motion carried unanimously.

3. ADMINISTRATIVE FISCAL MATTERS

A. Public Works Budget Request-Lawn Mower

Mr. Ferry reminded all that the request is a budgeted item and will be divided between the three funds. The total cost of the mower is \$11,679. Mayor Belisle stressed that this was budgeted & made motion to approve the purchase. Motion was 2nd by C. Fisher and carried unanimously.

5. NEW BUSINESS

A. Stalwart Films Facility Request

Seth Zimmerman of the Walking Dead asked Council to approve the permit request as applied for to use the wooden bridge for ½ day of filming tentatively scheduled for October 31st. Mr. Zimmerman stated that neighbors will be contacted and message boards will be set up and asked that two pieces of wood sticking out from the bridge be removed. C. Owens asked if the removal will disrupt the integrity of the bridge and if so, does not want to see this happen. C. Graham asked if camouflage can be used to cover up the two pieces & was told the construction crew will be consulted. C. Graham added that if they can't be covered up he is not in favor of

removal. After short discussion, Mayor Belisle made motion to approve the permit with the condition that no permanent alterations occur to the bridge. Motion was 2nd by C. Fisher & vote to approve was 4-0-1 with C. Grover abstaining from vote.
